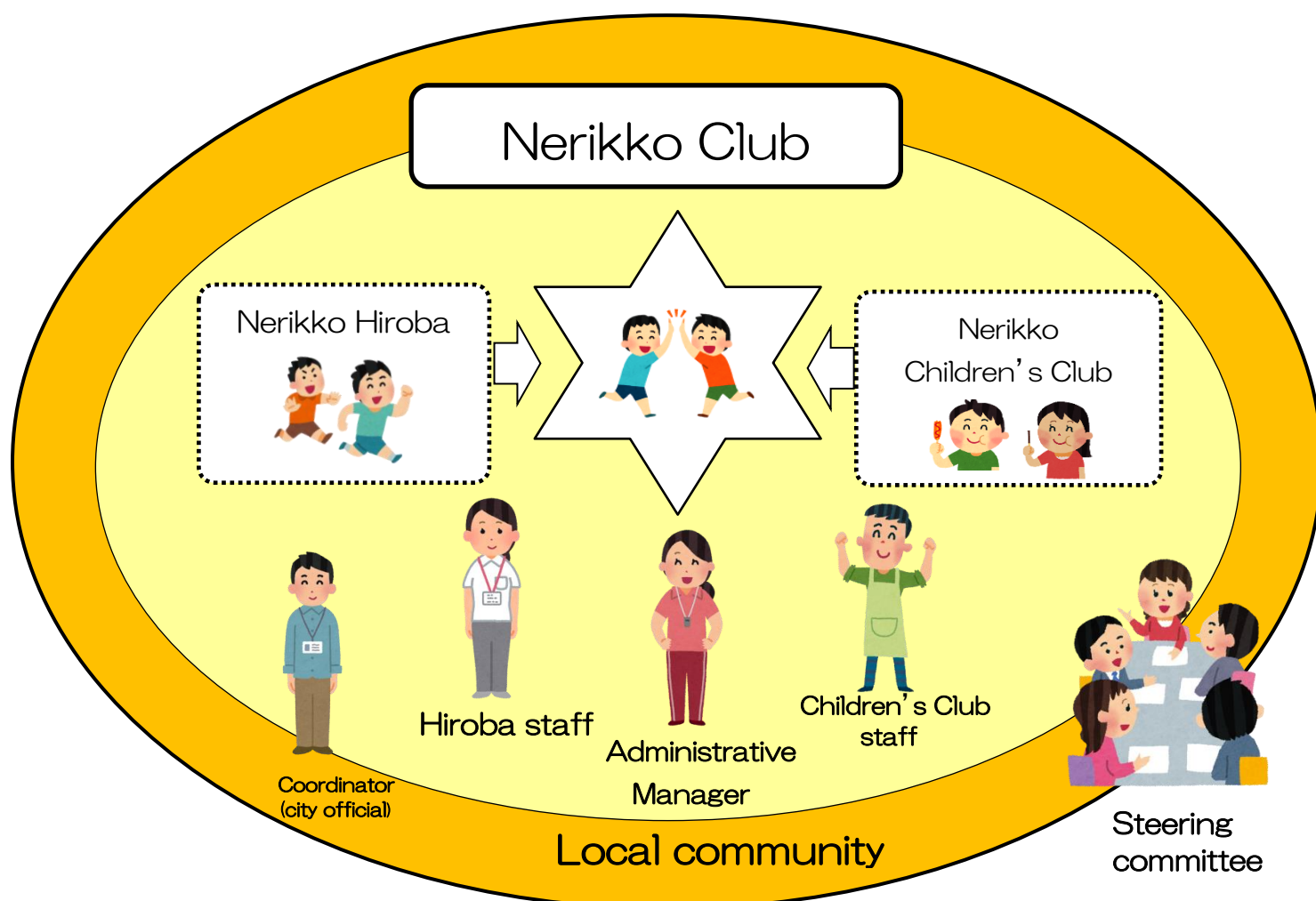

What is Nerikko Club?



It is a place where you can spend your time safely after school and during long school breaks such as summer vacation. You can join it if you are a student at a participating school or a member of that school's children's club.

We integrate operations of “Hiroba Project(*1)” and “Children's Club (*2)” maintaining their functions and characteristics. In a safe and secure environment on grounds of an elementary school, children can spend fulfilling after-school time with support from local community and through interaction with children in various grades, Hiroba staff and Children's club staff.



(*1)Hiroba Project It is an endeavor to provide “safe and secure place” for children within a school ground, they can go to Hiroba directly from classroom after school, and they are encouraged to interact with children of various ages and enjoy reading books there.

(*2)Children's Club It is a facility to look after children who need after-school care because of their guardian's work or some other reasons. Children enjoy playing and working together through various activities under the support of Club staff.

<Children's Club opening hours> After school* → Until 6 p.m.

Until 7 p.m. with extended stay

*On open days while there is no class (such as long school breaks), you can come from 9 a.m. (8 a.m. for Children's club members).

Children can stay in "Hiroba" at school without going home. Besides "Hiroba," you can choose where they should spend their time after school depending on his/her development and family circumstances.

It is a place children can use even during long school breaks such as summer vacation.

Children can experience various playing styles and activities through interaction with children in different grades, Hiroba staff, Children's Club staff and people from local community.

With good use of school facilities as activity space for children, we are trying to accept the bigger number of children to Children's Club.

Features of “Nerikko Hiroba” and “Nerikko Children’ s Club”

Prospective children	All students from participating schools and Nerikko Club members of that school ※Children can attend as many days as they need. How to apply • How to attend	Guardians must take registration procedure in advance. 【Registration time】 Students…Around February~ March New 1 st grader before entrance…After the entrance ceremony to be the 1 st grader Registration procedure can be taken in the middle of the school year. ※As to the starting date for the 1 st graders, we will notify after enrollment.

Attendance fee and Insurance premium	Insurance premium (Compensation) : 500yen/Year	Childcare fee : 5,500yen/Month Extension fee : 8am ~ 9am +500yen/Month 6pm ~ 7pm +2,000yen/Month
Attendance Check	Different from Children’ s Club, it is not a childcare facility. Children should agree with their guardians in the morning before going to school about the use of Hiroba and the time of coming home each day.	It is an after-school childcare facility. If a child does not show up without any notice, the staff will confirm the whereabouts of the child.
	“The Nerima Kids Safety Service” which notifies you when your child arrives at or leaves the facility is available (registration fee: 1,000 yen)

Lunch	Children can bring their own lunch when school lunch is not provided.	Children should bring their own lunch when school lunch is not provided.
